## MULTI-PURPOSE COMMUNITY FACILITIES PROGRAM- PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW

- Program Focus: Enhance community spaces to facilitate digital inclusion activities.
- Treasury Requirements:
  - $\circ$  Spaces that are open and available to the public.
  - Directly support work, education, and health-related engagement.
- Full funding amount: \$44,853,958.95
  - Minimum award amount: \$250,000
  - Maximum award amount: \$2 million
  - No matching funds are required



#### **ELIGIBILITY**

#### Assets

- Community anchor institutions such as community schools, libraries, recreation centers, community health centers, non-profit organization centers, and buildings owned or operated by units of local government.
- Aligns with Act 96 definition of CAI

#### Projects

 Construction or improvements to full-service community buildings, structures, and public spaces (such as schools, libraries, and community health centers that serve community needs).

#### Costs

- Pre-project development
- Costs of repair, rehabilitation, construction, improvement, and acquisition of real property, equipment (e.g., devices and office equipment), and facilities.
- Ancillary costs necessary to put capital assets to full use, including costs to increase broadband adoption and improve digital literacy
- Administrative costs 2.5%




### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Project must fulfill all the following criteria
  - Invest in capital assets designed to directly enable work, education, and health monitoring
  - Designed to address a critical need that resulted from or exacerbated by the COVID-19 public health emergency
  - Designed to address a critical need of the community to be served by it
- Project Sustainability
  - Ways property owner will cover all necessary costs
  - Acknowledge retainment of facility for a minimum of 5 years
  - Detailed plan for continued maintenance without federal funding
  - Detailed list of intended outcomes, outputs, activities, progress indicators, means of verification, and risk and assumptions
- Stakeholder & Community Engagement
  - Describe key partnerships
- Proof of Notification
- Planning and Permit Requirements
- Reporting
  - Quarterly and annual progress reports through project completion



### TENTATIVE TIMELINE



- Per US Treasury
   requirements, all funds must
   be committed by December
   31, 2024.
- All funded projects must reach substantial completion by December 31, 2026.
